Long Beach Transit Downtown Transit Hub Temporarily Relocated *Buses will stop along Ocean and Long Beach Blvd. for one month*

LONG BEACH, CALIF. (September 18, 2014) – From Saturday, September 20 – October 19, 2014, Long Beach Transit’s downtown hub will be temporarily relocated to Ocean Boulevard between Long Beach Boulevard and Pacific Avenue, and Long Beach Boulevard between Ocean and 1st Street. 1st Street between Long Beach Boulevard and Pacific will be closed to traffic, while the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) works on a major upgrade and modernization project of the Blue Line.

Four Metro Blue Line stations in Long Beach will also be closed: 5th Street Station, 1st Street Station, Downtown Long Beach Station and Pacific Avenue Station. The last Blue Line station into Long Beach will be Anaheim Street Station.

Free Metro shuttle bus service will be available from Anaheim Street Station along Long Beach Boulevard, Ocean and Pacific to connect train customers will buses or other destinations along the usual Blue Line route in Long Beach. Metro bus shuttles will operate at similar service levels as the Blue Line.

LADOT, Torrance Transit and Metro bus stops will be temporarily relocated to 1st Street, east of Long Beach Boulevard.

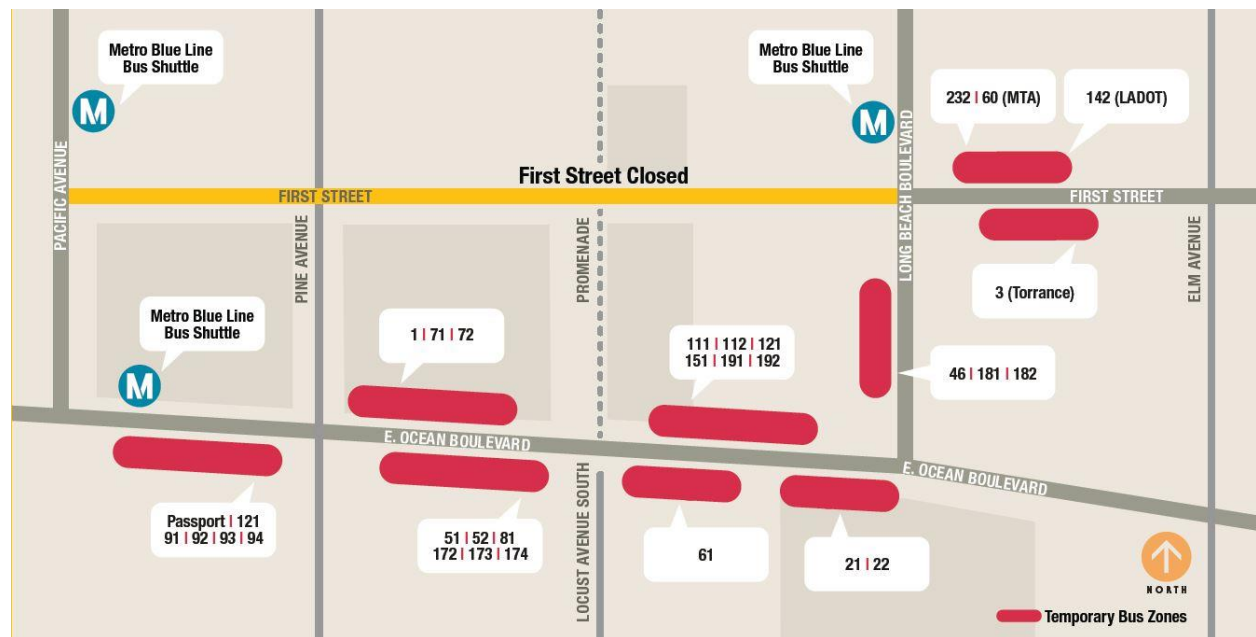
Metro bus shuttles will be stationed for boarding and exiting at:

Pacific Avenue (East Side of Street)	North of 1 st Street

46, 181, 182	Outbound	Long Beach Boulevard, just north of Ocean Boulevard. In front of International City Bank.
191, 192, 111, 112	Outbound	Ocean Boulevard, just west of Long Beach Boulevard. In front of International City Bank.
121	Inbound	Ocean Boulevard, just west of Long Beach Boulevard. In front of International City Bank.
151	Inbound & Outbound	Ocean Boulevard, east of the Promenade. In front of Downtown Plaza.
