Avoid Traffic And Take The Long Beach Transit AquaLink To The One Love Cali Reggae Fest 2018

LONG BEACH, CALIF. (February 9, 2018) – Getting in the island spirit for the One Love Cali Reggae Fest 2018 starts at the dock when concert goers can avoid car traffic by taking the Long Beach Transit AquaLink water taxi directly to the Queen Mary venue.

AquaLink service will operate from 4 p.m. to 1 a.m. during the run of the One Love Cali Reggae Fest 2018, Saturday, February 10 and Sunday February 11. AquaLink service connects Dock 4 at Rainbow Harbor with the Catalina Express dock near the bow of the Queen Mary. There is no additional charge to take AquaLink and a ticket to the event is required to board.

Concert goers arriving in downtown Long Beach on the Metro Blue Line can transfer to the free Long Beach Transit Passport Route that connects to Rainbow Harbor. Participants arriving by car may park at the structure near the Aquarium of the Pacific.
