**Long Beach Transit’s Museum Express Is Back for the Summer**  
*Customers Can Now Pay Online*

LONG BEACH, CALIF. (June 28, 2016) – Long Beach Transit (LBT) commences its 2016 Museum Express season on July 1, 2016 with a trip to the Getty Villa. Scheduled trips to popular cultural destinations are available Thursday through Sunday every week through September 4, 2016.

LBT’s Museum Express is a transportation service specifically developed to promote regional arts and culture along with public transit use. Trips are \$10 per person and include travel only. Each individual utilizing the service is responsible for their own admission to the venues. The 2016 venues include:
