



AUGUST 2017 PROPOSED SERVICE CHANGES

August 2017 Highlights

- Modify Route 176 to end at LBCC main campus
- Service hour reductions on 1, 96, 111/112, 121, 151, and school trippers to improve efficiency
- Improved service on Line 90 north of CSULB

August 2017 Highlights

- Route 1 – Some early morning and late night trips seven days per week will be removed due to low ridership and weekend service will be reduced from 40 to 50 minutes
- Route 121 – Weekday daytime service will be reduced from 18 to 20-25 minutes
- Route 151 – Weekday daytime service will be reduced from 20 to 27 minutes
- Routes 91 and 92 – Weekday service will be improved from 60 minutes most of the day to between 30 – 40 minutes at all times
- Route 93 – The majority of trips now ending at Lakewood Mall (Clark at Del Amo) will be extended to Alondra at Woodruff, improving service north of Lakewood Mall from 60 to 30 minutes
- Route 96 – Some late morning outbound and late afternoon inbound trips will be removed due to low ridership. Customers can access all stops via frequently operated service on Routes 91, 92, 93 or 94

Modification of Route 176

- Based on results of our Route 176 on-board customer survey, Route 176 will be modified to improve productivity
- Low ridership segments into the airport and Lakewood Mall will be removed
- Customers can still access the Lakewood Mall by using Routes 111 or 112 from PCH and Ximeno or Routes 93 & 112 from LBCC
- Customers can still access the airport by taking Routes 102, 104 and 111
- Customers can still access the airport by taking Routes 102, 104 and 111
- New bus stops to be added along new route
